New Multi-Purpose Loading Press



Corbin, the bullet swage die-makers, are offering a newly designed hydraulic/electric power press called the Hydro JuniorTM. Similar in appearance to the Corbin Hydro-PressTM used by nearly all custom bullet makers in 22

countries for the past two decades, the "Junior" model is priced at \$2000 less (\$3950 versus \$5950). It has the same power to extrude lead wire, swage bullets from .22 caliber to as large as 1-inch diameter, or reload ammunition from the smallest pistol calibers to 20mm cannon shells.

The difference is in the provision for automation and electronic control of the ram position and stroke. The Hydro JuniorTM uses two-hand push-button controls, with two adjustable position controls, top panel adjustable drive pressure, and a precision glycerine-filled pres-

sure gauge. The Hydro-Press[™] adds automatic stroke program control, electronic dwell timing, loading station stop point, additional pressure transducers and interfaces for control of Corbin copper strip feeders and jacket drawing heads.

The Hydro JuniorTM is designed for gun clubs, individuals who want to start a part-time home or retirement business (making custom bullets), or as a starting power press for gun shops expanding into the custom bullet and ammunition market.
